Ages 3 – Kindergarten: Spirit Play

Offered at all three services.

The goals of the Spirit Play classrooms at Unity are to share the stories that connect us together, to help children begin a search for their own answers to some big questions and to simply learn to be together in a kind and respectful way. Three-year-olds must be reliable in their toilet training before joining the classroom.

Grades 1 - 6: Workshop Rotation

Offered at all three services.

In our elementary school program the six-week units focus on five questions of classical theology: What is the nature of **God**?, What does it mean to be **Human** and alive?, How is the **Divine** present within each of us and in our lives?, What is the purpose of **Community**?, How do we live in the face of **Death** and **Loss**? The curriculum is delivered through six different workshops: Story, Art, Science, Drama, Music, and Kinesthetic.
