Respond to as many questions within 60 seconds. Responses should be quick and concise, with the option always of skipping any difficult questions. Interviewer may add questions as appropriate, especially if time remains. Teachers get interviewed, too!

Please begin by asking the first two questions, then selectively choose and/or add others:

2. What do you hope for from this class?

- What is your favorite holiday?
- What animal best describes you?
- What subject of study do you most enjoy at school? Least enjoy?
- What social justice work or organization inspires you?
- What word best describes your personality?
- What turns you on? What turns you off?
- What is one thing you admire about another culture?
- What is your most treasured possession?
- What is your favorite food? Least favorite food?
- What country would you like to live in?
- How old were you when you first started attending Unity?
- What do you want to be or do as an adult?
- What quality do you most admire in another person?
- Which living person do you most admire?
- What trait or quality do you least like about yourself?
- If heaven and God exist, what would you like to hear God say when you arrive at the heavenly gates?
- What is something about you that most people would NOT know right away?
- What do you consider your greatest achievement? Greatest failure?
- If there is one thing you could change about the world, what would you change?
- What is the best thing about being part of a community? Most challenging thing?
