2023-2024 Artist in Residence Program Unity Church-Unitarian St. Paul

The Artist in Residence program at Unity Church-Unitarian (aka Unity) seeks to cultivate generative relationships between the church and creatives across diverse art forms, to undertake a period of focused work with artists over a period of years that amplifies the congregation's vision of becoming a multicultural, antiracist Beloved Community. Through the exchange between the artist(s) and church community, presenting and sharing both the creative work and process, the program seeks to activate our imagination, foster relationships among and beyond our church walls, inspire spiritual and emotional growth, and open the church community to larger dimensions in the work of making cultural change.

2023-2024 Program Specifics

During the 2023-2024 church year, Unity's Artist in Residence program is seeking **one musician** or **one musical group**. This artist or group will perform in worship services on select Sundays, and may also collaborate with Unity's choral program, religious education program, or other community programming.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants must be 18 years of age or older, and may not be enrolled in a full time degree program. Applicants must be residents of the Twin Cities 7 - County Metro Area.

Applicants may be at any stage in their career, but must be able to demonstrate achievement in their artistic field and have a history of public presentation or community contribution in music. If applying as a group, all members must be individually eligible.

THE WORK

The selected artist or group will receive \$3,000 to create, prepare, and perform music for services and/or other church programs between January 1-May 30, 2024. These funds should cover the artist(s) payment, payment for any collaborators or guest artists, access to any sheet music, rights to perform certain pieces, or payment to composers, and any necessary equipment or instruments that the artist or group does not already possess. Please note that if a group is selected, payment for each group member must come out of this \$3,000 budget.

Applicants will be asked to propose a series of musical performances and activities that express Unity's values of "wonder, open-hearted engagement, and courageous action," that align with Unity's ends*, and that create meaningful connections between community members within and outside the walls of the church. Please visit the Unity Church-Unitarian <u>website</u> to learn more about Unitarian Universalism, who we are, our mission, values, and current programs. *Proposed projects may find alignment with existing programs and enhance or add dimension to an area of*

interest at the church. It is up to the applicant to describe how their work may fit with the church's programs and/or interests.

The selected artist or group will develop their planned musical performances in conversation with Unity Church ministers, Director of Music Ministry, and Worship Associates as part of the worship planning process, and will collaborate on creating worship services that are cohesive and aligned with each month's theme. The music will be one element—along with text, prayer, personal reflections, and sermons—of a larger service.

Unity Church-Unitarian St. Paul

Who we are: Unity Church-Unitarian is an intergenerational congregation of about 1100 adults and 450 children located in the Summit Hill neighborhood of Saint Paul, Minnesota. We strive for a deeply meaningful, transforming liberal religious experience, finding hope, beauty, and inspiration in our worship.

Mission: Unity Church-Unitarian fosters transformation through a free and inclusive religious community that encourages lives of integrity, service, and joy.

Values: Unity Church-Unitarian honors the ambiguity and uncertainty in the search for greater truth, meaning, and equity. In all we do, we strive to embody: wonder, open-hearted engagement, and courageous action.

The Artist in Residence program at Unity invites Twin Cities artists across disciplines (media arts, dance, music, literature, theater, performance, visual arts, or other) to apply for a 4 to 6 month residency in which the artist will create new artistic work and engage the church community with meaningful arts experiences to culminate in a public presentation of new work. Unity will provide compensation and support of up to \$7,000 for project research, development, community engagement programming, and the public presentation.

Please submit THREE audio or video samples of no more than 6 minutes each. These samples should be musical, and should feature you/your group performing. The music may be written by you, or by someone else. Each audio or video file should contain one musical piece or excerpt of a piece. Please do not edit multiple short excerpts into one video. Samples may be taken from a performance, rehearsal, audition, or any other type of recording.

Audio: Submit as link to YouTube, Vimeo, Spotify, or SoundCloud, or send directly as MP3 or WAV file.

Please include a Work Sample Information Sheet, which provides details about your samples (title, date, location, and if applicable materials/instruments used, composer credit, and collaborating artists). This may be submitted as a Word document or PDF.

SELECTION PROCESS:

Applications will be reviewed by the Artist in Residence Team, who will select an undetermined number of applications to move forward for interviews (in-person or online.)

One artist or group will be chosen out of this process. The Residency may begin as early as January 1, 2023.
