Pandya Cultural Norms:

- Pandyas prefer to interact with members of their own culture.
- Pandyas do <u>not</u> initiate conversation; they speak only when spoken to.
- Pandyas have very formal speech patterns. For example, they always use "sir" and "ma'am."
- Pandya females have more status than males, and Pandya males are chaperoned by Pandya females.
- Pandya males do <u>not</u> talk directly to females from other cultures; they avoid eye contact and respond through their chaperones.
- Pandya males can talk to males from other cultures; they can maintain eye contact with males from other cultures.

YOU ARE A CHISPA

Chispa Cultural Norms:

- Chispas are informal and friendly.
- Among Chispas, there are <u>no</u> gender roles; males and females behave the same way.
- Chispas are outgoing; they love to make contact with people from other cultures.
- Chispa contacts are brief and casual.
- ⊙ Chispas are democratic and call everyone by their name.
- Chispas value cross-gender contacts <u>more</u> than same-gender contacts.
