and in your life!

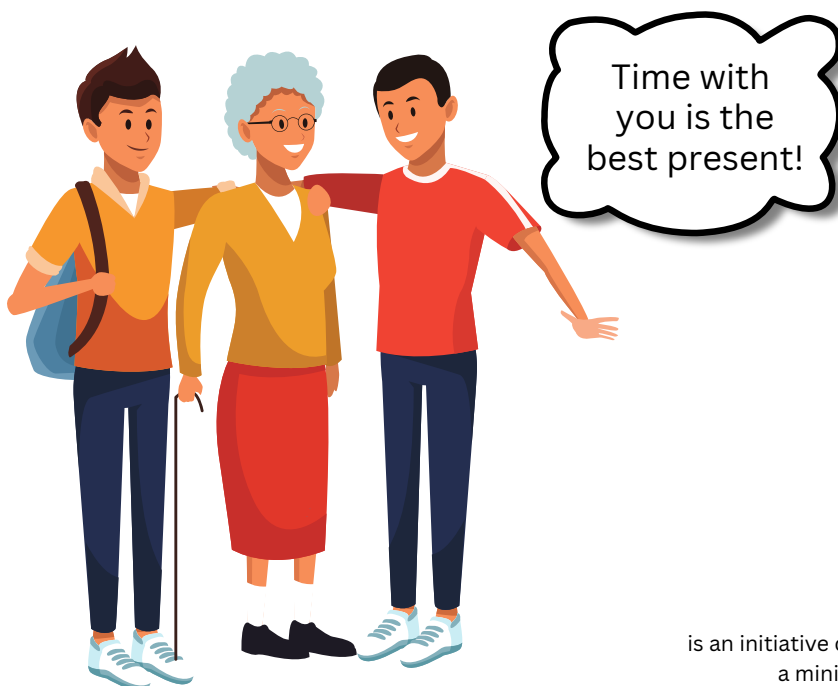
Gifts are important. So is the planet!
