Respond to as many questions within 60 seconds. Responses should be quick and concise, with the option always of skipping any difficult questions. Interviewer may add questions as appropriate, especially if time remains. Teachers get interviewed, too!

Please begin by asking the first two questions, then selectively choose and/or add others:

2. What do you hope for from this class?

- What’s your favorite holiday?
- What animal best describes you?
- What subject of study do you most enjoy at school? Least enjoy?
- What social justice work or organization inspires you?
- What word best describes your personality?
- What do you wish knew more about?
- What’s your favorite show to watch?
- What is your most treasured possession?
- What’s the farthest you’ve ever been from home?
- Where is your happy place?
- How old were you when you first started attending Unity?
- If you had a set of personal rules to live by, what’s a rule you would never break?
- Who inspires you to be a better person?
- What trait or quality do you least like about yourself? Most like about yourself?
- If you didn’t have to sleep, what would you do with the extra time?
- What’s something about you that most people would NOT know right away?
- What is your most-used emoji?
- If you could change one thing about the world, what would you change?
- What is the best thing about being part of a community? Most challenging thing?
